

Policy for Solid Waste Fees and Permits

For the Town of Anson, Maine

Rules and Regulations:

- I. **AUTHORITY:** These rules and regulations are promulgated pursuant to the Solid Waste Ordinance for the Town of Anson.
- II. **PURPOSE:** To efficiently operate the municipal solid waste program, it is necessary to establish rules and regulations that provide guidance to both municipal staff and the public.
- III. **DEFINITIONS:** The definitions provided in the Solid Waste Ordinance and in 38 M.R.S.A. Section 1303 apply to these regulations. Any word not otherwise defined shall have its ordinary meaning.
- IV. **AMENDMENT:** These rules and regulations may be amended by a majority vote of the Selectpersons following 30 days' public notice and a public hearing.
- V. **FEES:**
 - A. **Permits and Licenses:**
 1. **Commercial Hauler License:**
 - a. Effective 1/1/2026, the fee shall be \$125
 - b. Effective 1/1/2027 and continuing, the fee shall be \$250
 - B. **Residential Disposal Fees:**
 1. **Tires (Maximum of 6 tires per day):**

Motorcycle, race Car, Passenger vehicle (17" and under)	\$2.50
Truck (over 17")	\$6.50
Truck (over 17") on rim	\$12.00
Tractor/Skidder Tires	\$155.00
 2. **White Goods:**

Large Appliances (refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers, etc)	\$30.00
Items containing Freon	\$31.00
Small Appliances (counter appliances, toaster, microwaves, dehumidifier, etc.)	\$20.00
LP Tanks (1 to 10 lbs)	\$2.50
LP Tanks – 20 lbs	\$5.50
LP Tanks – 30 lbs	\$42.00
LP Tanks – 100 LBS	\$47.00
 3. **Brown Goods:**

Tv's, Monitors, DVD/VHS/CD Players	\$15.00
Computers/Scanners/Printers	\$15.00
Floor copiers/printers	\$30.00
Televisions (consoles)	\$30.00

VI. RECYCLABLES:

The Town of Anson encourages recycling. There are two ways to recycle:

- A. Single-stream (all recyclables can be stored and disposed of together at Waste Management). For a complete list of acceptable items, visit <https://www.wm.com> (a 2025 list is incorporated by reference); and/or
- B. Kennebec Valley Regional Waste Corp (curbside pickup services available twice monthly – North Anson on the 1st and 3rd Monday; Anson on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday). See Recycling Ordinance for the Town of Anson for a complete list of acceptable items.

VII. EFFECTIVE DATE:

This policy shall become effective upon adoption of the Solid Waste Ordinance for the Town of Anson, Maine as amended on March 7, 2026, AFTER 30 days advance public notice and a public hearing.
